The adjoining Bethesda Christian Mission School also received a much-needed upgrade to its power distribution system.

2 Pray as Ron Cline speaks at First Evangelical Free Church in Colorado Springs, CO, today and prepares to speak at Woodmen Valley Chapel, a church in the same city, four weekends in the next two months.

3 Pray as staff members at the HCJB Global Ministry Service Center in Colorado Springs meet offsite for their annual prayer retreat.

4 Pray as partner ministry LifeFM in Cork, Ireland, begins a systematic training program for volunteers at the station. Pray for the Basicks and others involved. Praise God for the two-year anniversary of the station and the great opportunity the staff had to march in Cork's St. Patrick's Day parade.

5 On this missionwide Day of Prayer, pray as a number of HCJB Global missionaries prepare for summer home ministry assignments. Pray for God's supply of needed financial resources as well as good times of visiting with family and friends, speaking in churches and making new contacts.
