

1 **Pray** for God's direction and much-needed resources to develop additional healthcare ministries in the Europe/Eurasia Region.

2 On this missionwide **Day of Prayer**, uphold the students taking part in HCJB Global's summer internship programs in Ecuador, Ireland, Ukraine and the U.S. **Pray** also for missionaries' children who have graduated from high school and are preparing to begin college this fall.

3 **Pray** as the HCJB Global European Conference is held in Schoorl, Netherlands, June 3-6. **Pray** for an effective time of fellowship, learning and development within the region.

4 **Pray** for the final testing and shipment of a 50,000-watt transmitter, modified at the HCJB Global Technology Center in Elkhart, IN, for use by Trans World Radio in Swaziland. Many more listeners in Swaziland and surrounding countries will receive the gospel broadcasts due to the wider coverage area of this modern transmitter.

5/6 Ed & Jean Muehlfelt, Elkhart, IN: "**Pray** that we would quickly settle back into life at the HCJB Global Technology Center after serving in the Europe/Eurasia Region (Scotland) for the past several years. **Pray** for wisdom and strength as we learn our new duties, including helping partner stations around the world with their radio projects." 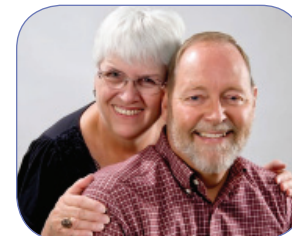

16 **Pray** for God's provision as HCJB Global-UK has launched a campaign to raise £96,000 (US\$143,000) to refurbish its building in Bradford. Plans are to create a Christian Media Centre focused on training and production that impacts the mainstream media with relevant gospel content.

17 **Praise** God for colleagues from Northwestern College in St. Paul, MN, who visited the Christian Center of Communications in Quito in April. Continue **praying** for the students as they complete the school year which ends in July.

18 **Praise** God for medical camps organized in a non-Christian slum colony in Delhi, India, in April. God provided doctors, volunteers and medicine to show God's love to unreached people. **Pray** for wisdom, protection and direction as Dolly and Christopher Kirubakaran and team make decisions about future opportunities for healthcare ministry.

19/20 Dwight & Susie Lind, Sierra Vista, AZ: "Continue to **pray** for the finances of the World Radio Network (WRN), especially those stations in Douglas and Yuma, AZ. We **thank** the Lord for our first year of marriage (our anniversary is June 20), and we look forward to many more years together." 23 Pray as radio trainers from HCJB Global Voice's Latin America Region hold workshops in Carthage, MO, and Raleigh, NC. Pray for clarity in the teaching and training of our colleagues and for wisdom in knowing the best way to use the great tool of radio that God has supplied for His glory.

24 Thank God for the new Spanish-language radio programs, "Café y Chocolate" (coffee and chocolate) produced by Mercedes Erazo and Fernando Arroyo, and "Parada 11" (bus stop 11) produced by Candice Figueroa and José Luis García. Pray for these programs to reach a wider audience, attracting more non-Christian listeners.

25 Pray for safe travels, good health and a renewed mission's vision for those taking the Eduard Klassen tour of New Zealand June 25-July 18. HCJB Global-New Zealand. Colin Sampson, director of the World Office, and his wife, Jean, are part of this group.
