August

1 Pray as HCJB Global's partners in the former Soviet Union hold radio training early this month. Pray for the trainees' safety and their future ministry.

2 Pray for prepared hearts, safety and good health for those who will travel on the HCJB Global Vision Journey to Greece and Turkey Oct. 15-29.

3 Praise God for the successful end of another term at the three-year Christian Center of Communications in Quito. Pray for God's guidance as graduates seek jobs in this field or take further education. Pray for the new group of students who will be entering the program later this fall.

4 On this missionwide **Day of Prayer**, pray as engineer Alan Good from the HCJB Global Technology Center in Elkhart, IN, makes a return trip to Haiti later this summer to replace computer equipment and train partners at *Radio Lumière*. His original trip was interrupted by the devastating earthquake that hit in January.

5 Praise the Lord that Hurricane Alex was not a major problem in the Rio Grande Valley in Texas. The area received plenty of rain and wind, but it had little impact on stations in the World Radio Network, one of HCJB Global's cooperating ministries with a network of stations along the U.S. - Mexico border.

6/7 Florence Judd, Shell, Ecuador: "Pray that my ministry inside Hospital Vozandes-Shell and in the community would be used by God to bless others. Pray for permanent staff for the ophthalmology department, more up-to-date equipment and development of current services." Florence serves in ophthalmology and administration at the jungle hospital in eastern Ecuador.



8 Pray as the eight summer interns who served in the Latin America Region return home after two months in Ecuador. Pray for safe travels, the adjustment back to their home culture, and continued ministry opportunities for each of these students.

9 Pray for God's leading as HCJB Global missionary candidates and other potential missionaries attend "Discovery" as well as "Training and Development" Aug. 9-20. The events are being held at the HCJB Global Ministry Service Center in Colorado Springs, CO.

10 Pray for the safe arrival of a shipment of 7,500 fixed-tuned, solar-powered SonSet® radios at the HCJB Global Technology Center. The sets feature several upgrades from the previous model, including a new receiver chip with improved performance, a more reliable push-button design, and a state-of-the-art rechargeable battery.

11 Pray for a good time of refreshment and making new contacts, family visits and church presentations as two missionary families from the North Africa/Middle East Region travel on home ministry assignments. Praise God for a Spanish-speaking volunteer who is helping at *Radio Vida* in Spain this summer.

12 Praise God for all the work in developing HCJB Global-Australia's international broadcast facility in Kununurra. Pray as Peter Michalke and engineer Steve Sutherland oversee the construction and installation of many of the remaining antennas. Pray for the safety of the staff and visitors assisting on this project.

Praise God for the hospital's ongoing physical and spiritual contribution to the community with hundreds of patients coming to Christ each year.

15/16 Jim & Trish Allen, Colorado Springs, CO: "Pray for wisdom in knowing which personal ministry opportunities to accept and what to do with the ones we take on. Pray as we seek God's guidance for our future as the time to 'slow down' seems to be approaching." 17 Pray for open doors to minister to the many U.S. troops who pass through Ireland en route to and from the Middle East. For most, it is their last stop on the way to Iraq and Afghanistan. Pray as Roger Basick at partner station LifeFM in Cork, Ireland, explores options for ministry in this area.

18 Pray for God's supply from British donors as HCJB Global-UK is feeling an economic pinch, especially in its general fund. Income for projects is "reasonably healthy," but finding money for general operating costs and administration has been a struggle.

19 Praise God that the Arabic satellite radio ministry operated by the North Africa/Middle East Region is broadcasting to a wider geographical area after some recent changes were made to the service.

Pray that we would take advantage of every opportunity to challenge others to join the effort, get involved and be a part of God's great desires for His people."
